#### **Creative auteur** Graduation project

For my post-graduation project in communication design, I created a student short film titled 'The Void.' This 30-minute film tells the story of Siddharth, a grieving young man struggling to cope with the loss of his father while living alone in a newly bought home—the very place where his father passed away.

Throughout the film, we delve into Siddharth's inner conflict, his interactions with the outside world, and the emotional turmoil he experiences. Drawing from my own experiences with grief, I embarked on a research journey that included studying literature, online narratives, films, artworks, and poetry. Additionally, I conducted interviews with individuals willing to share their experiences, primarily within my college circle.

Armed with insights from my research and mindful of budget constraints and my limited filmmaking experience, I outlined the film's structure, characters, and locations. Developing detailed character arcs, I sketched out the script and dialogue, before proceeding to create storyboards, raise funds, scout locations, and recruit suitable actors and team members.

Despite facing challenges due to limited funds, I took on multiple roles throughout the production process. However, the support of my team was instrumental in bringing 'The Void' to fruition.

## **Dissertation**(Internship) National Film Archives of India, Pune Aug 2019 - Feb 2020

During my dissertation, I had the chance to dive into Mahendra Kumar's archives at the National Film Archives of India in Pune. He was a cinematographer and a close associate of filmmaker Ritwik Ghatak.

My role wasn't just about saving and digitizing his work. I wanted to show how these photos fit into the bigger picture of what was going on in politics, society, and art back then. So, I pored over more than 2000 old photos, handpicking the most intriguing 160 based on different contexts. Then, I put them into six different narratives, each painting a unique picture of that era.

The result? A book that celebrates Mahendra Kumar's work and gives people a glimpse into the past. Whether you're a film buff or just curious about history, this book has something for everyone. And by putting it together, I hope to make sure that Mahendra Kumar's legacy lives on for years to come.
